SUMMARY OF THE *MEDICAL LIBRARY FORUM*

The periodical entitled *Medical Library Forum* ISSN 1899-5829 was established at the initiative of the directors of medical university libraries. Ryszard Żmuda Ph.D. has been appointed the Editor in Chief and Prof. Jacek Bartkowiak M.D., Ph.D. is the Chairman of the Program Council. This semi-annual journal with the Foreword written by noted persons has been reviewed by Professors and awarded points by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education (MSHE). The periodical has been financed by nine medical universities, namely Nicolaus Copernicus University, Ludwik Rydygier Collegium Medicum (Bydgoszcz), Medical University of Gdańsk, Medical University of Lublin, Medical University of Lodz, Poznan University of Medical Sciences, Pomeranian Medical University (Szczecin), the Centre of Postgraduate Medical Education (Warszawa), Medical University of Warsaw and Wrocław Medical University. Three universities have not contributed: Medical University of Białystok, Medical University of Silesia (Katowice) and Jagiellonian University in Kraków (Medical College). The first (9) jubilee issue of the fifth year volume for 2012 with the Foreword written by Professor Maciej Banach M.D., Ph.D., Under-Secretary of State in the Ministry of Science and Higher Education presents articles, papers and presentations from the scientific Conference in Poznan, information publications including *Guide*, *Bibliography* and *Dictionary* as well as teaching materials for PhD students.

The articles concern numerous aspects of science librarianship (Prof. Zbigniew Żmigrodzki Ph.D., Wiesława Tylman M.A., Prof. Dariusz Kuźmina Ph.D. Ewa Dobrzyńska-Lankosz M.A., Artur Jazdon Ph.D.), improving professional skills (Prof. Hanna Tadeusiewicz Ph.D.), Central National Universal Catalogue – CNUCAT (Maria Burchard M.A.) and the analysis of the MSHE journal quality list (announced on the 19th of September 2012), the concept of data quality and data validation as well as the ISSN-L

function presented by ‘Splendor Systemy Informacyjne’ (Jacek Głębocki M.A., Grzegorz Pietruszewski M.Sc.) as well as bibliometry (Anna Grygorowicz M.Sc.), academic journals (Prof. Wiesław Makarewicz M.D., Ph.D., Tadeusz Zaleski Ph.D., Piotr Kieraciński M.A., Katarzyna Jarkiewicz Ph.D., Anna Strumiłło M.A.) medialization (Prof. Marian Walczak Ph.D.), SYNAT (Henryk Hollender Ph.D.), science and culture digital resources (Aneta Januszko-Szakiel Ph.D.), Open Access (Anna Wałek M.Sc., Bogumiła Bruc M.Sc., Małgorzata Slesar M.Sc., Jolanta Przyłuska Ph.D.), electronic dentistry resources (Barbara Grała-Kociak Ph.D.) and methods of writing dissertations (Marcin Różalski M.D., Ph.D., Prof. Cezary Watała M.D., Ph.D.).

The fruits of the 30th Jubilee Problem Conference of Medical Libraries: Open Library – Open Science, which was held between 10th and 12th of September 2012 and organized by Aniela Piotrowicz M.A. the director of the Main Library of Poznan University of Medical Sciences include papers, presentations concerning the following issues: librarianship, scientific information, bibliometry, e-Learning, functioning of university libraries (Medical University of Gdańsk, Medical University of Silesia in Katowice, Medical University of Lodz, Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin, Poznan University of Medical Sciences, Medical University of Warsaw and Wrocław Medical University), information systems, periodical press, Open Access, websites, scientific information users, copyright, readership, e-books, exhibitions, consortia, country license resources, EAHIL, sponsors’ offers: EBSCO, OvidSP, BMJ, ProQuest, LWW, MEDtube, UpToDate and others. The photographic service provided iconographic documentation from the Conference in Poznań.

The present *Guide to Editorial Offices of Academic press in 2012* (Katarzyna Jarkiewicz Ph.D.) is designed to facilitate the Readers’ contacts with these institutions.

Retrospective *Bibliography of titles of academic information journals (1989-2012)* elaborated by Anna Strumiłło M.A. unveils the vast number of academic periodicals.

Profiles of four Professors – members of the *Medical Library Forum* Program Council are presented in *The Biographical Dictionary of Scholars* together with a detailed biography and bibliography arranged according to subject or author: Prof. Leszek B A B L O K M.D., Ph.D. – Medical University of Warsaw (Irina U t r a t a M.A.), Prof. Maria C H O S I A M.D., Ph.D. - Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin (Dagmara B u d e k M.A.), Prof. Gerard D R E W A Ph.D. - Ludwik Rydygier Collegium Medicum in Bydgoszcz (Anna G a r c z e w s k a M.A.) and Prof. Maria M A Z U R K I E W I C Z M.D., Ph.D. - Medical University of Lublin (Renata B i r s k a M.A.).

The review of the *Medical Library Forum* 2012 R. 5 No. 1 (9) was written by an outstanding scholar - Prof. Anna S i t a r s k a Ph.D. (Jagiellonian University in Kraków), who previously conducted her research, teaching and organizational activity at the universities in Lodz, Warsaw and Białystok; furthermore she was awarded the Adam Mickiewicz Prize for the Polish Librarian in 2001.
