SUMMARY OF THE *MEDICAL LIBRARY FORUM*

Medical Library Forum, no. ISSN 1899-5829, is a reviewed semi-annual nationwide periodical. It has been set up on the initiative of the Directors of the Polish Medical University Libraries and has been edited since 2008 by the Medical University of Lodz. Each edition is printed in 300 copies and is available on-line in the electronic version (<http://www.bg.umed.lodz.pl>; <http://cybra.lodz.pl/dlibra>). The periodical has been granted scores since 2010 by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education.

Prof. Marek M i r o w s k i , MPharm, PhD is the Chairman of the Programme Council and Dr Ryszard Ż m u d a , MA, PhD, the Director of the Medical University of Lodz Library, is the Editor-in-chief of the periodical.

In 2013, *Medical Library Forum* was supported by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education.

The articles concerning the activities of medical libraries, scientific information departments and related subjects have been published in the periodical. *Medical Library Forum* also includes current and historical issues. Moreover, teaching materials, bibliographic information, biographies, as well as reviews and conference reports are presented. The preface to the first issue of the sixth annual has been written by Rev. Prof. Józef M a n d z i u k , MA, PhD, Head of the Chair of Modern History, Institute of History, Faculty of History and Social Sciences at the Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University in Warsaw. This edition presents the articles on the following topics: the history of medical schools in Lodz, i.e. the University of Lodz, Medical Academy, Military Medical Academy and Medical University of Lodz (Prof. Jan B e r n e r , MD, PhD); Abraham Flexner's views on libraries and employees of the scientific information departments (Dr Danuta K o n i e c z n a , MA, PhD); certified librarians of the Technical

University of Wrocław (Marek Dubiński, MA, Mirosław Ziółek, MA); Internet access (Bogumiła Bruc, MA, Marie Källberg, Witold Kozakiewicz, MEng, Tuulevi Ovaska, Grażyna Prokurent, MA, Agata Trojanowska, MA); University periodicals (Tomasz Piotr Cichocki, MA, Dr Ryszard Żmuda, MA, PhD); archives (Anna Kozła, MA); libraries (Dr Marian Butkiewicz, MA, PhD, Ewa Dąbrowska, MA, Aleksandra Kojder, MA, Piotr Krajewski, MA, Piotr Kułak, MA, Tomasz Piestrzyński, MA, Ewa Rudnicka, MA, Aleksandra Siuciak, MA, Dr Krzysztof Zióło, MEng, PhD); and museums (Anna Ajdukiewicz-Tarkowska, MA, Prof. Iwona Arabas, MPharm, PhD, Prof. Zbigniew Bela, MPharm, PhD, Magdalena Cieplowska, MA, Dr Katarzyna Hanisz, Prof. Czesław Jeśman, MD, PhD, Joanna Jeśman, MA, Anna Poniędziałek, MA).
