hirelings, the shepherds, the small craftsmen. Beside them there are also these less numerous, but powerful members of the moneyed classes, the proprietors of vineyards and gardens, military colonists, and officials deriving great profits from the lease of taxes.

In her book the author has presented not only the economic situation of individuals and social groups, not only the exploatation by masters, and the revolt or resignation of the opressed, but also she has depicted their home- and family-life, daily interests and amusements, their beliefs and superstitions. From her account we come to know the people who are often so different from us, and at times very much like our selves.

With utmost ease the reader moves about in this remote world thanks to the almost novelistic presentation of the subject, the careful selection of documents and the chatting style of the author. The book has numerous well chosen illustrations which present not only the Egypt of the papyri but also these scenes and things from the contemporary Egypt which remind us of her ancient past.

It is a great merit of the author that she has written a highly readable story of ancient Egypt destined for wide circle of the readers who will follow with curiousity the uncommon problems, herebefore apparently remote and known to a small number of specialists. The fact that the book has gone into second edition testifies how excellent are its qualities. [H.K.]
