On February 2, 1964 died in Rome Professor Vincenzo Arangio-Ruiz. The sciences of Roman law, history and culture of antiquity lost one of the most distinguished scholars of our times.

Vincenzo Arangio-Ruiz was born in Naples on the 7th of May 1884. He studied law at Modena and Naples University. His first scientific research *Successione testamentaria secondo i papii greco-latini* was published in 1906. From 1907 he had lectures on Roman Law at the Universities of Catania, Perugia, Cagliari, Messina, Modena, Napoli, Cairo and from 1946 also at the University of Rome. In the years of 1952—58 he was a president of Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and from 1958 till his last days he was a vice-president of this Academy. He was a member of many academies and scientific associations in Italy and in other countries. In the government he was the Minister of Justice and the government to Rome he was the Minister of Justice.
